Three projects within KIC call 'Participating in the labour market' to start

Within the KIC call 'Participate in the labour market', NWO has awarded three projects. The three consortia, consisting of researchers at universities and colleges together with public and private partners, will receive a total of about 4.7 million euros.



Purpose of the call

Many people with a disability or chronic illness are currently unable to do the work they would like to do while the labor shortage is enormous. By deploying technological and/or social innovations and removing obstacles in legislation and regulations, these people could do work that fits their capabilities and ambitions. The assigned projects will contribute to new insights and (social and) technological innovations, with the aim of structurally improving equity and an inclusive labor market.

NWO-KIC: innovation programmes in the Knowledge and Innovation Covenant

NWO develops innovation programmes that focus on societal challenges in the Netherlands. These programmes aim to have an impact on the economy, people and society.
